

# Collegiate Women in Business (CWIB) Sponsorship 2021-2022

# **Leadership Program Sponsorship | \$5,000**

### Notes on all sponsorship opportunities:

- Sponsor presentations at general meetings are expected to follow the mission of the organization.
   While it is acceptable to spend five minutes or less of your presentation on employment
   opportunities, it is expected that the remainder of the content be used to empower, inspire, and
   develop our CWIB members. Speaker topics must be vetted prior to the meeting.

### More information on CWIB Activities

- Weekly Professional Development: CWIB hosts weekly meetings for all members. These meetings include
  inspiring presentations from industry professionals, skill development exercises, and networking between peer
  members.
- **Collegiate Workshops:** CWIB hosts an annual workshop designed to help women in the Ivy College of Business learn and develop a specific professional skill. Multiple speakers are invited to talk about the main theme for the year and share their insights. (e.g., networking or salary negotiation).
- **Professional Mentoring:** Each year, members of the club are assigned a mentor within CWIB's professional network. The mentor/mentee pairs communicate throughout the semester to discuss topics such as goals and professional development. Each semester, CWIB strives to host an event for members to meet with their mentors and network with other members.
- **Company Visits:** Each semester CWIB plans one trip to visit multiple companies in the area. In past years, students have visited and toured multiple companies in Des Moines and Minneapolis.
- **Formal Dinner:** In the fall, CWIB hosts a formal dinner to meet and network with Iowa State University faculty and staff.
- **Sponsor Dinner:** In the spring, CWIB hosts a sponsor dinner to show sponsors all that was accomplished throughout the year. This is a great time to network with all of the CWIB members.
- **Ivy Women in Business Awards:** Once a year, CWIB cohosts an awards ceremony with the Ivy College of Business to recognize successful women in the workforce.
- Young Women in Business Conference: CWIB cohosts a conference with the Ivy College of Business that is
  designed for high school women to visit campus and learn more about becoming a business major when they
  attend college.
- **Spring Break Leadership Trip:** In the spring, CWIB advisers take a select group of students on a trip to another state to visit a variety of companies and learn directly from prominent and successful business women across industries. In the past, CWIB has traveled to the Silicon Valley and San Francisco area. This is a great capstone for members who have worked through the CWIB programming through their collegiate years and are preparing to enter the workforce.
